Review of Selected Land Conflict Monitoring Indicators

The case profile tool was presented to review selected indicators contained therein. Among the discussions on the tool and indicators is the definition of area (not length but hectares), thus there is a need to multiply length to width of the area of conflict being monitored.

There is also a need to put the name of the affected group, unless the group demands not to do so. If there is no existing organization, then the sector and the village should be indicated on the form (E.g. farmers of XX village). There is also a need to clarify adversarial claimants, dominant drivers of conflict, and description of conflict.

Since the countries covered by the monitoring use different political subdivisions, then the form should reflect all of these subdivisions.
